PLATINUM BLOND LAGER

4.5% ABV

This Lager is made with American two row barley and wheat malt and fully fermented to make it a light refreshing beer.

GERMAN PILSNER

5.0 % ABV

This classic lager is brewed with European two row malt. Generous amounts of Saaz hops are added to the brew kettle giving this beer its wonderful hop character. Lagering for two months at 32 degrees F. allows for its natural carbonation and smooth taste to develop.

INDIA PALE ALE

7.2% ABV

A full bodied ale brewed with a variety of American hops to balance out the malt & alcohol. At 90 International Bittering Units it's not for the wimpy palate. Most Hop-heads will like this beer for their RDA of hops. This ale is best served with spicy dishes and goes great with any cigar.

ROJO-ATOR (DOPPLEBOCK)

6.8% ABV

This lager is brewed with dark German malts to give it a rich ruby red color. After fermentation it is kreausened with more fresh wort for natural carbonation. This malty lager goes well with salmon or pork dishes. Contrary to urban legend, it does not come from the bottom of the barrel or tank.

BELGIAN WHITE BEER

4.5 % ABV

The Belgians drink this refreshing ale during the hot summer months with their steamed mussels and pomme frites. This ale is brewed with raw wheat, that hasn't been malted, then fermented with a classic yeast strain. The combination of these two ingredients gives this beer its white haze and dense head. The unique flavor in this beer comes from two spices, coriander and orange peel.

ALTBIER (GERMAN ALE)

4.8 % ABV

These were the traditional ales brewed in Germany before lagers became popular. You can still find these ales brewed in the smaller breweries. A well balanced, bitter yet malty, clean, smooth, well attenuated amber colored German ale.

RUSSIAN IMPERIAL STOUT

11.8% ABV

The English brewed this style of stout for the Russian Czars. One thing was certain. This beer wasn't going to freeze at twelve percent alcohol during the cold Russian winters. This stout is brewed with twice the amount of malt & hops of most beers. The flavor is very roasted, coffee, sweet and a hint of coconut. It goes down warm due to the higher alcohol volume. We serve our Russian Stout in a brandy snifter to let it slowly warm up to release it's entire flavor. A great beer with cigars.

22oz. bottles, 12 per case

These seasonal ales were brewed by farmers with a variety of malts and grains such as oats, rye and wheat. After fermentation they were bottled up in old champagne bottles and used for lunch when planting or harvesting fields. The farmers would lay the bottles in cold streams to chill the beer. Our version is refermented with a wild yeast strain for a vinous flavor.

FLYING BUFFALO RUSSIAN IMP. STOUT

12oz. bottles, 24 per case

The English brewed this style of stout for the Russian Czars. One thing was certain. This beer wasn't going to freeze at twelve percent alcohol during the cold Russian winters. This stout is brewed with twice the amount of malt and hops of most beers. The flavor is very roasted, coffee, sweet and a hint of coconut. It goes down warm due to the higher alcohol volume. This ale is an American version of the classic barley wines from England. Rich malty and toffee notes are balanced well with American Hops to hide the alcohol profile.
