Normally hailed for their edible treats -- steak, lamb, seafood, ostrich, veal, among many others -- **Big Rock Chop House** is also host to award-winning signature beers. Brew master Dan Rogers has created four delicious recipes: Norm's Raggedy Ass Ale, a more bitter drink with lots of hops; Raymondo El Rojo, a dark caramel ale with a touch of roasted barley; Flying Buffalo Russian Imperial Stout, a thick, dark beer that won the bronze at the Great American Beer Festival in 2005; and the Platinum Blonde Lager, made with barley and wheat malt. Seasonal recipes are also available. Among them the German-style Bock, the Big Rock White, a Hefeweizen and more.
